Subject:- Holding of Online Limited Internal Competitive Examinations (LICEs) for promotion to Junior Engineer under 50% quota for RY 2016.

With the approval of the Competent Authority, it has been decided to hold a Limited Internal Competitive Examination (LICE) for promotion to the post of Junior Engineer (Telecom) under 50% Internal Quota for the Recruitment year 2016 only, as per the Recruitment Rules of Junior Engineer (Erstwhile TTA), circulated vide BSNL C.O. letter No. 250-7/2013-Pers-III dated 25.08.2014.

2. The aforesaid LICE would be conducted through Online examination mode in a centralized manner all over India by the Recruitment Branch of BSNL Corporate Office through the Examination Agency. However, the notifications for the aforesaid LICEs are required to be issued by the respective Circles. The time schedule prescribed for the aforesaid LICE is as under:-

With the approval of the Competent Authority, it has been decided to hold a Limited Internal Competitive Examination (LICE) promotion to the grade of JE(Erstwhile TTA) under 50% quota for the recruitment year 2016. The exam will be conducted online. The examination shall be held as per Recruitment Ruled circulated vide letter No. : **250-7/2013-Pers-III dated 25.08.2014** and Syllabus/ Scheme of the examination circulated vide letter No. : **250-76/2001-Pers.III dated: 07.10.2011.**All Departmental candidates fulfilling the prescribed eligibility conditions and possessing qualification as detailed in above letters will be eligible to apply for the above said post.

Syllabus for each of the two sections has been detailed in Annexure A.

4. As already informed vide BSNL CO letter No. 5-11/2009-Pers.IV dated 01/11/2011, the examination will be of multiple choice objective type and as such each question will have 4 multiple choices for answer. Only **one** answer which is the most appropriate has to be selected by the candidate and click the relevant option accordingly. In case of wrong answer, 25% marks of that question will be deducted and as such the candidates are advised not to resort to arbitrary selection of answer.

Minimum Qualifying marks in the LDCE for TTA will be as follows :-

5. Eligibility:-

The eligibility criteria for appearing in LICE are as under:

The following Non-executive employees of BSNL, below the age of 55 years as on the **Ist July 2016**, are eligible provided they are possessing 10+2 standard qualification or equivalent or two year ITI certificate/three year Diploma in any one of the disciplines **i.e.** Telecommunication/Electronic/Electrical/Radio/Computer/Instrumentation/InformationTechnolog y from a central Govt./State Govt. recognised institutions after matriculation.

i. Non-executive of any cadre (viz. Telecom, Telecom stores, Civil, Architect, etc.) in the IDA pay scale of Rs. 9020-17430 and above with combined five years of residency period in the pay scale of Rs. 9020-17430 or above as on 1^{st} July 2016.

ii. Senior Sports Assistants and Sports Inspectors/ Coordinators in the IDA pay scale of Rs. 9020-17430 and above with 5 years of residency period in the scale of Rs. 9020-17430 or above as on 1^{st} July 2016.

iii. Non-executive (Industrial & Non-Industrial) of Telecom Factories in the IDA pay scale of Rs. 9020-17430 and above with 5 years of residency Period in the scale of Rs. 9020-17430 or above as on 1^{st} July 2016.

6. The LICE will be held in **all BSNL Territorial Circles** at their respective headquarters. The details of the Territorial Circles where the LICE will be conducted are given at **Annexure-B**.

7. The examination will be conducted strictly in accordance with provisions of Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for conducting Computer based Online examination in BSNL.

8. The employees, who are eligible in accordance with the eligible conditions as referred in the Recruitment Rules and who desire to appear in the examination should submit application on-line. Candidates applying for LICE for promotion to the post of Junior Engineer are required to apply online for which link shall be provided through BSNL web site <u>www.internalexam.bsnl.co.in</u>. Applications will be considered only through the online registration process which is to start from **15.12.2017** and will be closed on **15.01.2018**.

Therefore, candidates are advised to visit BSNL Intranet site (www.intranet.bsnl.co.in) for any updates regarding the LICE.

All candidates applying for LICE for **Junior Engineer** are required to read all the instructions provided on website <u>www.internalexam.bsnl.co.in</u> before filling the online application form. Candidates will have to provide valid Email ID and Mobile Number at the time of online Registration. After submitting the application on-line, the applicant may take a print out of application form and keep it with him/her for record.

9. The prescribed examination fee **Rs. 500**/-(Rupees Five Hundred only) for the OC/OBC candidates and **Rs. 250**/- (Rupees Two Hundred Fifty only) for the SC/ST candidates shall be paid through online mode i.e. Internet Banking, Credit Card, Debit Card only.

The amount of the fee shall not be accepted in any other form. Fee once paid shall NEITHER be refunded under any circumstances NOR can be held in reserve for any other examination or selection. Hence, the candidates are requested to ensure their eligibility for the said LICE before applying for the same.

10. Registration forms complete in every respect must be submitted Online on or before 15.01.2018. Candidates are advised to complete their registration process well before last date to avoid last day. Registration process will not be allowed after last date and all incomplete registrations will be treated as rejected. Candidates will have to download their Admit Card from the BSNL website www.internalexam.bsnl.co.in at least 7 days before from the date of the Online Test by using their user name & password. It will not be sent either by post or by email. BSNL shall not be responsible for server crash problems or delays occurring on last day of registration.


11. The applicants would be admitted to the examination on the basis of the information furnished by them in their registration form. They are, therefore, advised to ensure that they fulfill all eligibility conditions before applying. In case it is found at a later stage that the information furnished by an applicant is false or an applicant does not fulfill any of the eligibility conditions, the candidature of such applicants would be cancelled and no correspondence in this regard would be entertained. Issuance of an admit card for the examination will NOT confer any right for promotion/appointment. Promotion/appointment will be solely subject to fulfillment of all eligibility conditions as well as availability of vacancies.

12. No electronic gadget or mobile phone will be permitted to be taken inside the examination premises by the candidates.



SYLLABUS

SECTION-I ELECTRICALS, ELECTRONICS AND COMMUNICATION

ELECTRICAL---Three-phase versus Single phase supply, concept of inductance and capacitance and impedance in AC circuits, series and parallel AC Circuits, star and delta connections, relation between phase and line voltage. Ohm's Law and its application. Power factor and their measurement, refrigeration and air conditioning. Principles of operations of Transformer, application of small transformer in electronics and communication engineering. Semi-conductor devices—Principles of operation and characteristics of diode, zener diode, transistor. Application of these devices in electronics circuits e.g. half wave/full wave rectifiers, invertors etc. Electronic Circuits—Basic electronic circuits viz. amplifiers, oscillators, multi-vibrators and integrated circuits (ICs). Units of attenuation, decibles and Nepers, characteristics of attenuation and concept of low pass (LP), band pass (BP) and high pass (HP) filters. Concept of dbm, psophometric noise, cross-talk and their measurements,


COMMUNICATION---Modulation and demodulation—principle and operation of various types of AM, FM and PM modulators/demodulators; pulse modulation—TDM, Multiplexing, principles and application of PCM.

NETWORK, FILTERS AND TRANSMISSION LINES---Transmission lines and their application, characteristic impedance of line, principle of impedance matching, bandwidth consideration of a transmission line.

COMPUTERS---Computer and its working, types of computers, familiarization with DOS and windows—concept of file, directory, folders, number system (Binary, Octal and hexadecimal), Memory types, Personal computers and their typical uses, types and working of modems, OSI models.

SECTION-II DEPARTMENTAL PRACTICES

- (i) Various types of subscriber instruments, exchanges viz. C-DOT, RAX/SBM/MBM/E-10-B/New Technology Max-I and their working principles.
- (ii) Transmission systems functioning in DoT/BSNL and their working principles.
- (iii) Telex and Trunk working principles/repair/maintenance.
- (iv) Float rectifiers, power plant, engine alternator, batteries their operation and maintenance.
- (v) Operation and maintenance of 3 channel system.
- (vi) Repair of PCBs, connectors, soldering, de-soldering and pin-number in IC chips. Handling of ICs.
- (vii) Type of switch-boards, cables, their identification and laying/terminations.
- (viii) Organizational set up up-to Telecom Circle level.
- (ix) PABX, MDF, IDF, Racks, Ruses, Relays.
- (x) Various types of tools.
- (xi) Earthing practices and methodology.
